Aarya taught on a total of 27 Saturday's in the nine months from 9 AM to 12 Noon. Apart from the above Aarya specially came in to help out in summers when one of our volunteer s was unavailable and taught for 6 days from 18<sup>th</sup> May 2019 to 24<sup>th</sup> May 2019. We really appreciated this as it was in midst of his school holidays and on a very short notice. During this period Aarya tutored for 5 hours daily. With his hard work and dedication Aarya encouraged students to complete their Class X board examinations. It was our pleasure having a young dedicated volunteer in OISCA. Aarya also assisted OISCA staff in collecting Educational Aids from his neighbouring community for the students in the Literacy class. He was also involved in the Literacy program for under privileged children. The classes were conducted for five days a week starting 8<sup>th</sup> July to 26<sup>th</sup> July, 2019 from 5.00- 6.30 pm. Aarya was teaching basic English and Maths to 20 children.

Aarya was also helping us with the administration work as well as the Environment Education Project- Children's Forest Program.

**Program responsibilities-** Children's Forest Program- active contribution to field trips; organizing plantation drives; organizing environment awareness programs in rural and urban schools in Noida and Gurugram.



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The Children's Forest Program (CFP) is a unique tree planting campaign utilizing schools systems and featuring children as a main actor. Started by OISCA in 1991, the CFP has spread in more than 25 countries which is a step towards our goal of establishing community forest worldwide, therefore making a positive and concrete contribution in communities.

CFP is an experimental environment learning program. Through this program, not only children but the community itself will be educated on the importance of forest, love of greenery and eventually expand this circle of activities from school level to communities.

Aarya was also involved in organizing two health camps for families from Sarai Kale Khan. An OPD camp was organized on 11<sup>th</sup> May, 2019 and December 14<sup>th</sup>, 2019. Around 250 patients had attended the camp.

Aarya is an analytical, self motivated and a diligent individual. He completed all tasks assigned to him in a professional manner and strove to improve with each endeavour.
